7) Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

(a) Initiative: Job & Career Fairs

Lynn University. Boca Raton, FL. March 25, 2015. A Marketing Facilitator participated in the Career Fair. The Employment Unit solicited students interested in careers in broadcasting for internships. The career fair had 75-100 attendees.

Keiser University. West Palm Beach, FL. April 21, 2015. A Marketing Facilitator participated in the Career Fair. The Employment Unit solicited students interested in careers in broadcasting for internships. The career fair had 40 attendees.

(b) Initiative: Internship Program

The Employment Unit operates an internship program, which allows interns to gain experience in many areas of the radio industry. Internships are available year round. During the period covered by this report, 35 interns participated in the program and received college credit. Internships are available in the areas of programming, sales, promotions, and administration. Depending on the main focus of the internship, interns may report directly to a sales manager, general manager, program director, or promotions director. Interns learn a wide variety of skills, including but not limited to: writing on-air copy and promotional announcements, website maintenance, writing and sending out press releases, miscellaneous office responsibilities, assisting on-air talent with remote broadcasts including set-up and tear down, board-oping and help with show producing, and recapping events for clients. Interns are recruited from the many universities, colleges, and technical colleges around the area, including Palm Beach Atlantic, Northwood University, Connecticut School of Broadcasting, Florida Atlantic University, Lynn University, Nova Southeastern University, Palm Beach Community College, University of Florida, Keiser University and University of Miami.

(c) Initiative: Job Shadowing Program

Good Karma Broadcasting instituted and provides a job shadowing program. In this program, students from area high school and colleges visit the station and shadow an Employment Unit employee for an entire day, giving them a feel for careers in the broadcasting industry.

(d) Initiative: Mentoring Program

The employment unit has implemented a mentoring program called Big Brothers/Big Sisters. It is intended to pair up Good Karma Broadcasting teammates (*i.e.* employees) across markets and encourage veteran teammates and new teammates to develop a relationship, share ideas and advice and become a resource for each other.

(e) Initiative: Participation in Educational Institution and Community Events

Reach for the Star Gala (November 8, 2014): The Employment Unit's Journalist was a celebrity blackjack dealer at the Kravis Center in West Palm Beach, FL for a fundraiser benefiting Young Friends of Kravis/Youth Programs. About 300 people were in attendance.

Breast Cancer Research Foundation Luncheon (February 5, 2015): The Employment Journalist's co-hosted a lunch at Breakers in Palm Beach, FL. This fundraiser benefited Breast Cancer Research Foundation. About 400 were in attendance.

Little Smiles Starts Ball Gala (February 7, 2015): The Employment Unit's Journalist emceed a live auction at the Himmel Theatre in City Place, FL. This event benefited the Little Smiles organization. About 300 were in attendance.

Huntington Lakes Men's Club (March 8, 2015): The Employment Unit's Director of Content spoke to the Men's Club in Delray on the topic of sports journalism. About 150 men in attendance.

Dr. Oz for Kids Sanctuary Campus (March 28, 2015): The Employment Unit's Journalist emceed the benefit that was held at a private residence in Old Palm, FL. About 65 were in attendance.

Ernie Els for Autism (April 4, 2015): The Employment Unit's Journalist emceed the events at the Harbourside Place in Jupiter, FL. About 300 were in attendance.

Boy Scout Pacesetter Luncheon (April 9, 2015): The Employment Unit's Journalist emceed the event at the Kravis Center in West Palm Beach. About 300 were in attendance.
